## **Crossroads Chrysalis Appropriate Behavior Covenant**

While it is important, as part of the Crossroads Chrysalis Community, to have the freedom to display a Christ-like affection toward one another, there is a need to produce a written statement identifying what will be considered acceptable and unacceptable expressions of Christian love and concern. It is understood that we are all sinners and fall short of God's wonderful plan for our lives, and that we do not always adhere to what we know and understand to be the biblical standard for moral behavior.

In addition to seeking Christ's forgiveness for our sins and rejoicing in the new chance at life He gives us, the Board of Directors for the Crossroads Chrysalis Community is compelled to take a clear stand against the moral confusion which is so pervasive in our society and culture today.

It is the Board's hope that in establishing guidelines for appropriate and inappropriate moral behavior within the Crossroads Chrysalis Community sponsored events, that Caterpillars and Butterflies who come to these events and chose to become members of the Crossroads Chrysalis Community, along with Board members, Team members, and other members of the Chrysalis Community, will not be the recipients of unwanted attention or actions that may cause them discomfort, humiliation, and pain, or be led into actions and lifestyles that are incompatible with a Christ-centered lifestyle that honors God.

With that purpose and goal in mind:

I recommit myself to living my life according to the highest standards of morality set forth in the Scriptures. I understand those standards to include sexual fidelity within the bonds of marriage, celibacy outside of marriage, loyalty in all friendships, and a sacred obligation to seek the best for others, even when doing so means that I must make personal sacrifices.

I agree to avoid any conscious acts of harassment in all aspects of my life, but especially in any Crossroads Chrysalis Community sponsored events in which I participate and in any contact I have with members of the Crossroads Chrysalis Community outside of sponsored events.

I agree that the definition of behavioral (including sexual) harassment will be understood as:

Unwelcome behavioral and sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or other physical, non-physical, or psychological conduct of a sexual or threatening nature which is found to be highly offensive from the viewpoint of a reasonable person of the same sex as the individual affected by the behavior.

I understand that the statements in the document above describe the standards of behavioral conduct expected of me as a servant of Christ as I live my life and as I serve in the Crossroads Chrysalis Community. I agree to abide by them.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR CHRYSALIS TEAM PARTICIPATION**  
**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THIS TEAM APPLICATION**

The team selection process is a prayerful and careful blending of youth and adults, which involves the Chrysalis Board, Weekend Lay Directors, and the Chrysalis and Emmaus Communities. Many names are prayerfully considered and with the Lord's guidance a team is selected to meet the needs of the particular weekend. Potential team members are contacted by telephone and asked to prayerfully consider service on the upcoming Chrysalis weekend.

*Before completing this application, please review the date of the team training listed below. If you will need to miss this meeting, the Chrysalis Board asks that you do not apply for team at this time. We do understand that emergency situations, but need to inform all applicants that if training is missed, you will be asked to excuse yourself from team service.*

**THE DATES ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

*Training is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Weekend in January – Friday, 7:00 pm through Sunday 4:00 pm.*

*Boy's Flight begins on the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of February through Sunday*

*Girl's Flight begins on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of February through Sunday*

When you receive a call to serve on team, pray about your answer. Team formation begins long before the weekend flights. It is much more than saying "Yes". The privilege of serving on team calls for sacrifice, obedience, and commitment. Being on team takes a lot of time and work. Pray for the willingness to serve in any capacity. Serving a meal is just as important to the weekend as giving a talk. Each member of the team is part of the puzzle. When put together, they form a oneness in Christ.

**There is a fee of \$150** for team members to pay, due by the last team meeting. This covers the cost of your housing and food at Innabah for the weekend. We do have some scholarship money available, however, you are responsible for making the arrangements to obtain that scholarship money. Speak to the Community Lay Director if paying all of your team fee becomes a problem.

As a team member, please realize that you will be responsible to follow all the same rules as caterpillars attending the flights. This means **NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** at any Chrysalis function, including through the duration of a flight. You are a role model for the youth we lead as well as the adults in our Crossroads Community. Your behavior is more important than what you say in helping each person who sees you toward obedience to the rules.

Crossroads Chrysalis has developed an Appropriate Behavior Policy which outlines biblical standards for Christian living. A signed copy of this policy must accompany your application to serve on team.

Applicants who are or will be 18 years of age by the date of the flight, you must submit a current PA State Police Criminal Record Check and PA Child Abuse History Clearance no later than the first team meeting. Applicants must renew their clearances every three years.
